What is COP29?

The Conference of the Parties (COP), is held annually, with the Presidency rotating between the five recognised UN regions.

This year, Azerbaijan has been selected as the Presidency of the 29th Conference of the Parties (COP29), to be hosted in Baku this November. Azerbaijan has a strong track record of hosting international events and has chosen Baku Stadium as the venue for COP29.

To deliver a process that is transparent, impartial and inclusive, the COP29 Presidency has developed a plan based on two mutually reinforcing pillars to enhance ambition and enable action.

COP, which stands for Conference of Parties, is the series of formal meetings Conference of Parties, where governments assess global efforts to advance the Paris Agreement and the Convention, also limit global warming to 1.5°C as informed by the latest science. At COPs, world leaders come together to measure progress and negotiate the best ways to address climate change.

There are now 198 Parties (197 countries plus the European Union) to the Convention, constituting near universal membership. The next Conference will take place in Baku, Azerbaijan, in November 2024

BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO IZMIR DOUGHNUT ECONOMICS CONCEPT

The *Izmir Gevrek Model*, inspired by **Doughnut Economics**, is an initiative by **Izmir Municipality** to create a sustainable, inclusive, and ecologically balanced city. Named after the local pastry "Gevrek," the model represents the delicate balance between social and ecological well-being. It seeks to keep Izmir within ecological limits (e.g., reducing carbon emissions) while meeting social needs (e.g., improving quality of life and promoting social justice).

Key Objectives:

1. Prevent exceeding ecological limits, with a goal for Izmir to become a zero-carbon city.
2. Strengthen the social foundation by enhancing quality of life and advancing social justice.

Roadmap:

- Izmir's five-year strategic plan (2025-2029) is driven by two core questions:
- How can Izmir protect its environment in urban development?
- How can Izmir ensure a high quality of life while respecting planetary boundaries?

To achieve this, the model **follows seven key pathways**, adapted from Doughnut Economics:

1. **Thriving City:** Align local goals with global responsibilities to create a vibrant city.
2. **Collaboration:** Strengthen partnerships between the metropolitan municipality, district municipalities, and Aegean region municipalities, and align these with national and global goals.
3. **Promoting Sustainability:** Encourage innovative, ecosystem-friendly behaviors and capacity-building among citizens.
4. **Holistic Thinking:** Integrate holistic approaches to protect and improve Izmir's ecosystem and the broader environment.
5. **Data Transparency:** Facilitate open access to socio-economic and ecological data to support decentralized decision-making.
6. **Sustainable Work:** Focus on creating jobs and conditions that regenerate and enhance life cycles, rather than endless growth.
7. **Adaptability:** Commit to transparency and flexibility by adjusting strategic decisions as needed over time.

Methodology: The model's implementation relies on four main areas:

1. Establishing a comprehensive "Gevrek" database for data-driven planning.
2. Developing a participatory city portrait to involve citizens in defining Izmir's identity and goals.
3. Engaging businesses to align the economic landscape with sustainable practices.
4. Conducting educational programs and promotional activities to foster broad support for the model.

Through these pathways and methods, Izmir aims to foster a thriving, ecologically balanced city that respects social and environmental boundaries, benefiting present and future generations.
